Opening

Closing

- 1 Respect neighbours, -please leave quietly.
- 2 Check equipment is returned satisfactorily to storage. Chairs and tables stacked as requested.
- 3 Check music and lighting systems are turned off.
- 4 Check kitchen and appliances, including utensils are clean, tidy, returned to storage and turned off as necessary.
- 5 The cooker is cleaned (not left with spilled food or dirty pans in the oven!).
- After using the dishwasher it must be put through the drain cycle. This requires the plug to be removed which is located under the right hand filter, then turn programme dial to drain. When complete filters and the inside of the dishwasher need to be washed and wiped clean.
- 7 Check floors are clean. Sweep/clean as required.
- 8 Check windows are closed and locked.
- 9 Check toilets lights out and water off.
- 10 Ensure fire doors are closed.
- 11 Report and pay for any breakages.

The Hall is run by volunteers therefore your cooperation in the above, leaving the Hall clean and tidy after an event is requested.
